Utility Bills are mailed out the last *working* day of the month and are due by the 10th of the following month. Accounts outstanding by the 15th day of the month will be sent a late/disconnect notice and be assessed a late penalty fee. If disconnected, the customer will be charged a \$200 deposit if a deposit does not already exist. A second disconnection may require an additional deposit. Electrical service will be turned off, or interrupted, on the 26th of the month; or the closest work day (Monday through Thursday). **Hand Watering (flower beds or gardens):**

Customer holding or controlling the water hose or device any day & time.

**March 1st to October 31st:**

No watering allowed between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.

**From November 1 to the last day in February:**

Watering permitted on prescribed days at any time.

**Automobile Washing or Real Property Clean-up:**

Customer must use a control nozzle on the hose.
